BYLAW NO. 14-2019

**A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION & PARKING OF
VEHICLES AND THE USE OF THE HIGHWAYS**

The Council of the Town of Watson, in the Province Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the **Traffic Bylaw**.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

For the purpose of this bylaw, the following terms and words shall have the following meanings:

- 2.1 **“angle parking”** means the parking of vehicles with the right front wheel drawn up on the right-hand side of the highway, or at a distance of not more than thirty(30) centimeters from such curb, the vehicles to be placed at an angle of forty-five (45) degrees with the curb;
- 2.2 **“administrator”** means the administrator of the municipality;
- 2.3 **“all terrain vehicle”** and/or **“ATV”** means all terrain vehicle as defined in *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*;
- 2.4 **“council”** means the council of the Town of Watson;
- 2.5 **“curb”** means the lateral boundaries of a roadway, whether or not marked by curbing;
- 2.6 **“highway”** means a road, parkway, driveway, square, or place designated and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area and does not include a provincial highway within the municipality as designated pursuant to the provisions of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*;
- 2.7 **“justice”** means a justice of the peace as per *The Interpretation Act, 1995*;
- 2.8 **“lug vehicles”** means any vehicle with a portable engine or tractor engine having metal spikes, lugs or cleats projecting from the face of the wheels or tires thereof, or having metal track tread;
- 2.9 **“municipality”** means the Town of Watson;
- 2.10 **“parallel parking”** means the parking of a vehicle with both right wheels thereof drawn up to the curb on the right-hand side of the highway of the highway, or a distance of not more than thirty (30) centimeters from such curb;
- 2.11 **“parking”** has the meaning ascribed thereto by *The Traffic Safety Act*;
- 2.12 **“place of public assembly”** means schools, theatres, churches, rinks, and halls;
- 2.13 **“power turn”** means to maneuver a vehicle in such a manner to cause part of the vehicle to depart from its ordinary line of progress by the sudden use of acceleration and/or braking;
- 2.14 **“designated officer”** means the Administrator, Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Sheriff, Bylaw Enforcement Officer or any other person appointed to enforce

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municipal bylaws;

2.15 “**u-turn**” means the turning of a vehicle so as to cause it to proceed in the opposite direction from which it was proceeding immediately prior to the commencement of such turn;

2.16 “**vehicle**” means a vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer or a motor vehicle as ascribed to by *The Traffic Safety Act*.

3. SCOPE

3.1 “**Stop**” Streets: highways listed in *Schedule “D”*; *Map “A”*

3.2 “**Yield**” Streets: highways listed in *Schedule “E”*; *Map “A”*

3.3 “**No U-Turn**” Intersections: intersections of the highways, approached from all four (4) directions listed in *Schedule “C”*;

4. INFRACTIONS

4.1 “Stop” Streets:

The provisions of *The Traffic Safety Act* shall apply to all traffic approaching and facing a “stop” sign erected and maintained in accordance with the provisions of *subsection 5.1*

4.2 “Yield” Streets:

The provisions of *The Traffic Safety Act* shall apply to all traffic approaching and facing a “yield” sign erected and maintained in accordance with the provisions of *subsection 5.2*.

4.3 Miscellaneous Signs:

4.3.1 No person shall, except where authorized by resolution of Council, or when duly authorized by law, erect upon or immediately adjacent to any highway, any sign, marker, signal or light or any advertising sign or device.

4.3.2 No person shall deface damage, destroy or remove any sign or marker erected pursuant to this bylaw.

4.4 Lug Vehicles:

4.4.1 No person shall propel, operate or drive any lug vehicle upon any highway within the municipality without first obtaining from the administrator, a permit in writing authorizing same.

4.4.2 The administrator is hereby authorized to issue permits in writing for the purpose of *clause 4.4.1* of this bylaw, in any case where the applicant therefore has signed a written undertaking

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in *Form 1, Schedule "G"*. Provided that the administrator shall not issue any such permit unless he/she is satisfied that with reasonable care in operation, the lug vehicle may be propelled or driven over any highway without damage resulting thereto or to any bridge or culvert thereon.

4.4.3 Nothing contained in *clause 4.4.1* shall be deemed to preclude the transport of a lug vehicle as herein defined over any highway where same is being carried by means of a rubber-tired trailer or other conveyance equipped with rubber tires.

4.5 Heavy Truck Route:

4.5.1 No person shall operate a vehicle or a combination of vehicles when the combined gross weight of the vehicle(s) with or without a load exceeds 12,000 KG. except on a highway within the municipality designated as a heavy vehicle route indicated on Schedule "F", Map "B" hereto attached and forming a part of the Bylaw.

4.5.2 Subject to Subsection 4.5.1 no person shall operate a vehicle or a combination of vehicles when the combined gross weight of the vehicle(s) with or without a load exceeds 35 tonnes on any highway within the municipality.

4.5.3 *Subsection 4.5.1 and 4.5.2* shall not apply to vehicles making delivery on any highway in the municipality provided that the operator of the vehicle(s) uses the most direct route from and to the heavy vehicle route.

4.5.4 Council shall cause to be erected and maintained appropriate signs indicating the locations where the use of heavy truck is prohibited, as set out in *Schedule "F", Map "B"*.

4.6 Parking:

4.6.1 Except as otherwise provided herein, the parking of vehicles is permitted on all highways within the municipality.

4.6.2 4.6.2.1 Subject to the provisions of *sub clause 4.6.2.2*, no person shall park a vehicle in any lane, or in any street so as to obstruct the entrance to any lane or to a driveway or approach leading to private premises;

4.6.2.2 Notwithstanding the provisions of *sub clause 4.6.2.1*, a vehicle may be parked in any lane for the purpose of taking on or discharging cargo, provided no such vehicle shall be parked for a period exceeding thirty (30) minutes at one time, unless written permission has first been obtained from the administrator or a designated officer of the municipality for an extension of such time.

4.6.3 4.6.3.1 Subject to *sub clause 4.6.3.2*, every person parking a vehicle upon a highway within the municipality where parking is permitted, shall

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parallel park the same.

4.6.3.2 Every person parking a vehicle upon a highway listed in *Schedule "A"* shall angle park same.

4.6.4 No person shall park a vehicle in any "No Parking" area as designated in *Schedule "B"* at any time whether such areas are marked on the curb or otherwise by signs erected and maintained in accordance with the provisions of *subsection 5.4* to indicate that parking therein is prohibited.

4.6.5 No person shall park a vehicle within five (5) metres of any street intersection or fire hydrant.

4.6.6 No person shall park a vehicle on any highway at one place for any period of time exceeding forty-eight (48) consecutive hours.

4.6.7 No person shall park any vehicle in any private place or on any private property unless he is the owner, occupant, licensee or permittee of the parking place or private property, except with the consent of such owner, occupant, licensee or permittee.

4.6.8 **4.6.8.1** Subject to *sub clause 4.6.8.2*, no person shall park any vehicle designated for carrying or intended for the carrying of oil, gasoline or other flammable, combustible or explosive material, within 30 metres from the building in the municipality used or intended for use, in whole or in part, as a place of dwelling, a hotel or place of public assembly.

4.6.8.2 Nothing in *sub clause 4.6.8.1* shall be deemed to restrict the parking of any such vehicle for such period of time as may be necessary to take on or discharge cargo.

4.6.9 No person shall park any vehicle in a parking area designated/reserved for persons/vehicles with valid handicap stickers or permits.

4.7 Power Turns:

The operator of a vehicle shall not execute "power turns" on any highway in the Municipality.

4.8 Snowmobiles:

The Council of the Town of Watson in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

4.8.1 Subject to the provisions of *The Snowmobile Act* and to Sections 4.8.2 and 4.8.3 of this bylaw a snowmobile operator may utilize any street, avenue or lane within the town being the most direct route from his residence to the limits of the Town.

4.8.2 It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on the following street and avenues only for the purpose of crossing the said street or avenues in the most direct route:

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- 4.8.2.1** Railway Avenue North;
- 4.8.2.2** Highway 6 within town limits;
- 4.8.2.3** Main Street North from Railway Avenue North to 3rd Avenue North.
- 4.8.3** A snowmobile may be operated only between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. and at a speed not exceeding 20 kilometers per hour.
- 4.8.4** Notwithstanding the provisions of this bylaw, the council may, subject to any term and conditions may impose, issue a permit for a specific snowmobile event.
- 4.8.5** The provisions of this bylaw do not apply to a designated officer when engaged in the performance of his duties.

4.9 Speed:

- 4.9.1** Subject to *clause 4.9.2* no person shall operate a vehicle in the municipality at a speed greater than 40 km.
- 4.9.2** No person shall operate a vehicle at a speed greater than forty (30) km per hour in the speed zones as set out in *Schedule "H"*.

4.10 U-Turns:

- 4.10.1** No person shall cause a vehicle to make a U-Turn between intersections, and at the intersection of a highway with a lane or an alley in the municipality.
- 4.10.2** No person shall cause a vehicle to make a U-Turn at the intersection designated as a "U-Turn" intersection as listed in *Schedule "C"*. This shall apply to all traffic approaching and facing a "No U-Turn" sign erected and maintained in accordance with the provisions of *subsection 5.3*.

4.11 Vehicles on Public Reserves, etc.

- 4.11.1** No person may operate or park a vehicle on any area designated on *Map "C"*.
- 4.11.2** The provisions of *clause 4.6.4* shall not apply to maintenance or vehicles using a designated parking area.

4.12 Bicycles:

- 4.12.1** No person shall operate a bicycle without having

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at least one hand on the handle bar.

4.12.2 No person shall operate a bicycle on a sidewalk.

4.13 Loading Zones:

4.13.1 No operator of a vehicle shall remain in a loading zone for a period exceeding two (2) minutes for the purpose of embarking or disembarking passengers, provided that on the expiration of the two minute period the onus of proving the loading and unloading of goods shall rest with the driver of any vehicle found in such a loading zone.

4.13.2 No operator of a vehicle shall remain in a loading zone for periods exceeding ten (10) minutes for the purpose of loading or unloading goods.

4.14 All Terrain Vehicles:

4.14.1 Subject to the provisions of the *All Terrains Act* and to Sections 2 and 3 of this section an all terrain vehicle operator may utilize any street, avenue or lane within the town being the most direct route from his residence to the limits of the Town.

4.14.2 It shall be lawful to operate an all terrain vehicle on the following street and avenues only for the purpose of crossing the said street or avenues in the most direct route:

4.14.2.1 Railway Avenue North;

4.14.2.2 Highway 6 within town limits;

4.14.2.3 Main Street North from Railway Avenue North to 3rd Avenue North.

4.14.3 An all terrain vehicle may be operated only between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. and at a speed not exceeding 20 kilometers per hour.

4.14.4 Notwithstanding the provisions of this bylaw, the council may, subject to any terms and conditions for the council may impose, issue a permit for a specific all terrain vehicle event.

4.14.5 The provisions of this section do not apply to a designated officer when engaged in the performance of his duties.

5. SIGNS

5.1 Council shall cause to be erected and maintained at all stop streets in *Schedule "D", Map "A"* at a distance of approximately three (3) metres from point of intersection, an appropriate sign containing the word "Stop", so placed to face the traffic approaching the intersection.

5.2 Council shall cause to be erected and maintained at all yield streets listed in *Schedule "E", Map "A"* at a distance of approximately three (3) metres from

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point of intersection, an appropriate "Yield" sign, so placed to face the traffic approaching the intersection.

- 5.3** Council shall cause to be erected and maintained at all "No U-Turn" intersections as listed in *Schedule "C"*, at a distance of approximately three (3) metres from point of intersection, an appropriate sign prohibiting U-Turns, so placed to face the traffic approaching the intersection.
- 5.4** Council shall cause to be erected and maintained at all "No Parking" areas as listed in *Schedule "B"*, appropriate signs and/or curb markings. Such signs or curb markings shall be visible from that part of the highway to which the restriction applies.

6. PENALTIES

6.1 Signs:

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of *clauses 4.3.1* and *4.3.2* of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

6.2 Lug Vehicles and Power Turns:

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of subsections *4.5.1* and *4.7* of this bylaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of:

6.3 Parking, U-Turns, Public Reserve, Loading Zones:

A person who contravenes any of the provisions of subsections (here list all the sections) of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith or with any of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith or with any notice or order given there-under shall be guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction, shall be liable to penalties as follows:

6.4 Notice of Violation:

6.4.1 A violator of any of the subsections of this bylaw, as set out in *subsection 6.3* upon being served with a Notice of Violation, may during the regular office hours, voluntarily pay the penalty at the municipal office within 30 days and upon payment as so provided, that person shall not be liable to prosecution of the offence.

6.5 Bicycle Contravention

The penalty for the contravention of *section 4.12.1 and 4.12.2* is as follows:

6.5.1 for the first infraction impounding the bicycle for 2 days; and

6.5.2 for the second or additional infractions, impounding the bicycle for 2 days.

6.6 All Terrain Vehicle Contravention

The penalty for the contravention of *section 4.5* shall be liable to the penalty imposed by section 32 of *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*.

6.7 Speed, Failing to Stop, Failing to Yield etc.

The penalties for these and other traffic violations other than parking under *The Traffic Safety Act, The Snowmobile Act* and *The School Bus Operating Regulations* shall be liable to the penalties imposed by *The Summary Offences Procedure Act* and/or any other applicable legislation.

7. IMPOUNDING

7.1 In addition to and notwithstanding any provisions contained within Section 6 hereof, any person appointed as a designated officer pursuant to this bylaw:

7.1.1 may remove or cause to be removed any vehicle

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that:

- 7.1.1.1** is unlawfully placed, left or kept on any street, public parking place, or other public place;
- 7.1.1.2** is unlawfully parked pursuant to *clause 4.6.7* when requested by the owner, occupant, licensee or permit holder of said land; or
- 7.1.1.3** is found on a street, highway, public parking place, other public place or municipally-owned property when:
 - 7.1.1.3.1** *the owner of the vehicle owes three or more outstanding fines to the municipality for parking offences;*
 - 7.1.1.3.2** *the appeal period against the imposition and amount of said fines has expired;*
 - 7.1.1.3.3** *at least two notices that the fines are outstanding were sent to the owner at least one week apart; and*
 - 7.1.1.3.4** *a justice, having been satisfied by evidence provided by way of oath, affidavit or statutory declaration of the existence of the facts mentioned above in clauses 7.1.1.3.1 to 7.1.1.3.3, has issued an order authorizing the removal and impoundment*
- 7.1.2** and seize, impound or store such vehicle.
- 7.2** The municipality may retain a vehicle which has been impounded or stored after it has been removed under *subsection 7.1* until the amount of outstanding fines, if any, and the costs incurred in removing and impounding or storing the vehicle have been paid, and upon payment of said outstanding fines and costs the vehicle shall be released to the owner.
- 7.3** If the fines and costs described in *subsection 7.2* have not been paid within a period of 30 days (*longer if Council wishes*), the municipality shall have the right to recover same from the owner of the vehicle by:
 - 7.3.1** legal action in a court of competent jurisdiction;
 - 7.3.2** sale through public auction; or
 - 7.3.3** by private sale of the vehicle.
- 7.4** Prior to the sale of a vehicle which has been impounded or stored under this section, the municipality shall provide notice designating the time and place of the sale at least 14 days (*longer if Council wishes*) prior to the sale by:
 - 7.4.1** publishing a notice in a newspaper circulating in the municipality;
 - 7.4.2** sending a copy of said notice by regular mail to the owner at the address last appearing on the vehicle registration; and
 - 7.4.3** by any other means which council may consider appropriate.
- 7.5** The proceeds from such sale shall be applied firstly on the fines and costs described in *subsection 7.2* and the balance remaining, if any, shall be paid to the owner.
- 7.6** If the proceeds from such sale are insufficient to satisfy the fines and costs described in *subsection 7.2*, the amount of the shortfall shall be a debt due and owing from the owner and enforceable by the municipality in any

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manner allowed by law.

8. REPEAL

Bylaw No. 04/19, 01/17, 05/15, 01/13 and any other amendments for the traffic bylaw are hereby repealed.

9. COMING INTO FORCE

This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the final day of its passing.

I declare that:

- (1) I will use reasonable care in propelling, operating or driving such lug vehicles over the highway to prevent any damage resulting to the highway.
- (2) I will, when operating such lug vehicle over any bridge or culvert on any highway or on any specified bridge or culvert thereon, first lay down on such bridge or culvert planks or timbers of not less than 5 cm in thickness and should extend a minimum of 300 mm wider on each side than the maximum outside width of the lugs; such planks or timbers to be laid lengthwise across the bridge or culvert in the direction in which the lug vehicle is proceeding in such a manner that they will support the wheels or tread of the lug vehicle on both sides thereof throughout its entire passage over such bridge or culvert.
- (3) I will pay for all damages caused to such highway or to any bridge or culvert thereon as a result of propelling, operating or driving such lug vehicle thereon.
- (4) I understand that lug vehicles are not allowed to travel on or across provincial highways unless a written permit is obtained from the Department of Highways and Transportation.
- (5) I understand that all municipal bridges have secondary weight limitations unless posted otherwise and I will ensure that I comply with any and all weight restrictions.
